

Community Care Center

People should not have to gamble with their health. Every day thousands of people in our community bet that they won't need a doctor, dentist or emergency assistance. They earn too much to qualify for government programs, but not enough to afford health insurance or pay a physician's bill.

Community Care Center was formed by physicians of the Forsyth-Stokes-Davie County Medical Society in response to this need. This free medical and dental clinic serves the medically uninsured (no Medicaid, Medicare or private insurance) of Forsyth, Stokes and Davie Counties whose family incomes are less than 200% of the federal poverty level.

Since the opening of Community Care Center on October 23rd, 2000, over 17,500 patients have been served, with over 153,000 patient visits. Community Care Center is by far the largest free medical and dental clinic in NC. Although the clinic was envisioned as a way for retired physicians to give back to their community, practicing physicians soon joined their retired colleagues. In 2002, we added volunteer dentists, who now see patients two evenings each week.

In 2009, our active volunteers included 150 physicians, 23 nurses, 1 PA, 4 NPs, 45 dentists and 4 mental health counselors. The annual value of donated professional services (including volunteer hours, x-rays/ultrasounds, labs) rose from \$1.3 million in 2007 to \$5 million in 2010.

Community Care Center patients are provided the medicines they need, primarily through free medicines acquired from pharmaceutical companies. The value of medications received during the year increased from \$1,302,315 in 2007 to \$5,535,000 in 2010. Med Aid, a program of Community Care Center which secures medications for non-CCC patients, also received medicines valued at \$4,161,000 in 2010.

In just 10 years, Community Care Center has become an indispensable part of our local safety net. Our sources of funding in 2010 were: Grants - 56.8%, United Way - 17.2%, Contributions - 23.6%, and Misc. - 2.4%.
