Effective **March 1, 2011**, the reportable range for INR labs done at FMC will **increase** from 9.0 to 20.0. INRs greater than 20.0, will be reported as >20.0. The methodology for acquiring the results as well as the reference range will remain the same. Additionally, the PT in seconds will still be reported as >100 if they are higher.
